

Question 1-26: Fill in the blank. 80%

1. A: What's all this paint for? (you) **Are you going to** paint your house?
B: No, we **are going to** paint my mother's house. (*will or be going to*)
2. A: Would you like to join Linda and me tomorrow? We **are going to** visit the natural history museum. (*will or be going to*)
B: Sure. I've never been there.
3. ALFONSO: What's that?
NURSE: A needle. I (*prepare*) **am preparing** to give you a shot.
ALFONSO: I (*need, not*) **don't need** a shot!
NURSE: Just relax and breath deeply. Everything will be fine.
ALFONSO: Ouch!
4. Dr. Sato (*perform*) **has been performing** specialized surgery since she began working at the university hospital ten years ago. She still does many operations each year, but now her work is so famous that she travels all over the world lecturing to other surgeons on her technique.
5. A: You're going out?
B: Yes. I **am going to** go to the grocery store for some fruit, meat, and rice. Can you think of anything else we need? (*will or be going to*)
A: How about some chocolate-covered nuts?
B: I said "need"!
6. The marathon runner (*run*) **had been running** for almost two hours when he collapsed to the pavement. He received immediate medical attention.
7. We were not happy with the plans that the architect showed us for our new house. Obviously, he (*never design*) **had never designed** a home like the one we wanted.
8. I'm surprised that George apologized for what he said. As far as I can remember, I (*never hear*) **have never heard** him say "I'm sorry" before.
9. A: Why isn't Richard here?
B: I (*imagine*) **imagine** he'll be here soon. Don't worry about him.
10. A: How much longer until we arrive at Singapore airport?
B: Let me see. It's about 9:15. We (*fly*) **have been flying** for almost six hours. We should be there in another couple of hours.

11. The club members (*make, finally*) **have finally made** their decision. The election is over, and they (*choose*) **have chosen** a new president. Ann Andrews is now the club leader.
12. Mark missed his physics examination this morning because he **overslept**. He **has overslept** a lot since the beginning of the semester. He'd better buy a new alarm clock. (*oversleep*)
13. Ivan **has played** the violin with the London Symphony since 1990. Last year he **played** Beethoven's violin concerto at one of the concerts. (*play*)
14. I **knew** Tim when he was a child, but I haven't seen him for many years. I **have known** Larry, my best friend, for more than 20 years. (*know*)
15. A: What are you doing?
B: I (*smell*) **am smelling** the scent of this candle. It (*smell*) **smells** good.
16. Last Saturday while Sandy (*clean*) **was cleaning** out the attic, she (*find*) **found** her grandmother's wedding dress.
17. Last night we suddenly (*wake*) **woke** up from a sound sleep when we (*hear*) **heard** a noise about 3:00 A.M. I thought it was a burglar, but it was only a cat that (*walk*) **was walking** along the window sill.
18. The police (*outwit*) **outwitted** a thief yesterday. They (*surround*) **surrounded** the jewelry store while he (*stuff, still inside*) **was still inside stuffing** the pockets with diamonds.
19. We (*had*) **had** a wonderful dinner last night to celebrate our 25th wedding anniversary.
20. Sally is falling asleep at her desk. Dr. Wu (*lecture*) **has been lecturing** since ten, and it's now past noon.
21. Amy (*hear, not*) **didn't hear** her parents having argument last night. She (*listen, in her room*) **was in her room listening** to music.
22. A: Do you let Tommy use scissors? He's very young.
B: It's not a problem. He (*be*) **is** very careful when he cuts something with scissors. He knows how to use scissors carefully.
23. A: I need some help.
B: What can I do, Andy?
A: I **am going to** go to a job interview this afternoon, and I don't have a decent tie to wear. (*will or be going to*)
B: I **will** lend you one of mine.
A: Thanks. (*will or be going to*)

24. A: BYE, Alex.

B: Wait! (you, forget, not) **Aren't you forgetting** something?

A: What do you mean?

B: Gosh. Yes. How could I forget that? Thanks.

25. Promptly at five, I went to Iris's office to offer her a ride home from work, but I couldn't find her. She (already, leave) **had already left**.

26. By the time Jason arrived to help, we (already, finish) **had already finished** moving everything.

27. 我家共有五個人，除了雙親之外，我還有一個弟弟和一個妹妹。

(除了 besides; in addition to)

There are five members in my family. Besides my parents, I have a younger brother and a younger sister.

28. 父親很少有應酬，下班後時常與我談到我在學校的生活狀況，他是很關心子女的。

(應酬 social appointments, 關心 show concern for; be concerned about)

My father rarely has social appointment. After getting off work, he often talks with me about my school life. He shows great concern for us children.

29. 我們過著簡樸的生活，然而在我們的內心深處都覺得生活中是不能沒有對方的。

(簡樸 simple, 內心深處 deep in heart)

We live a simple life. However, we feel deep in our hearts that no one can live without the others.

30. 雖然不過五十來歲，但滿臉的皺紋似乎在告訴我他已經歷盡各種艱難。

(五十幾歲 in one's fifties, 皺紋 wrinkle, 經歷 come (go) through, 艱難 hardships)

Though he is only in his fifties, the wrinkles in his face seem to tell me that he has come through many hardships.
